Catechetical Sunday September 20, 2020

"I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you."

(1 Cor 11:23)

Every year on the third Sunday of September when the New School Year and all CCD Programs are going in full swing the Church in the United States designates as **Catechetical Sunday**. It attaches a theme to the year that can be utilized as kind of mission statement for this year's efforts.

This year's theme is a verse from St. Paul's first letter to the Corinthians 11:23 in which he is talking to the disciples of Jesus at the City of Corinth about the Eucharist. I encourage you to pick up your Bibles and read the whole of chapter 11 of St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians.

Therefore, the work of this year in our catechetical efforts ought to be all seen in the context of the Eucharist. All of our catechizing should lead to the Eucharist and flow from it. The Eucharist is the very heart and center of our faith.

What St. Paul is saying to the Corinthians is that what he is preaching and teaching them, albeit specifically on the Eucharist but can be extended beyond that, is no mere human invention. His teaching is not just the mere words of men but come from the life of Jesus, the Son of God who suffered, died and rose for us. That word is the Word of Life in which we find salvation. It is the Word that he received from the Lord, himself.

The Word that Paul says teaching is what Christians have been passing on from the time of Christ. It is a sacred trust on which all depends and defines and reveals the truths of reality for us. We have come to call it the Deposit of Faith. We continue to teach it for in that word we find the deepest meaning of life and the preparation we need for eternal life.

Jesus had all of this in mind when he commissioned the Apostles immediately before His Ascension as he said, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always until the end of the age." Mt 28:18-20.

Our efforts at Catechizing are therefore so important for so much depends upon it. I ask, therefore that all take these efforts seriously. The Catechists are such good people and volunteer so much of their time to fulfilling the Lords command. I pray that they will receive the full support of the parents and full attention of our great young people.

We place all of our efforts under the patronage of the ones who taught Jesus from in His youth, his mother, Mary and foster father Joseph.
